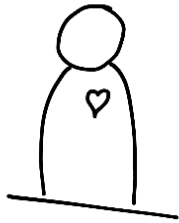
Learning Experience of Students & Trainees

Physical / Environmental

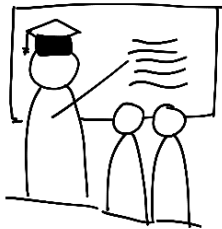
Social

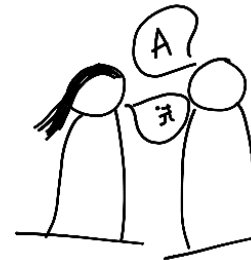
Cultural
